

## MOH Press Release 22 April 2022

Stopping of free Community ART testing and weekend Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) testing at the Combined Test Centres (CTCs) and Quick Test Centres (QTCs).

We had previously provided free community ART testing and weekend ARI testing at our CTCs and QTCs during the Omicron wave to alleviate the workload at GP clinics and other healthcare facilities. With the declining case numbers and easing of load at the Public Health Preparedness Clinics (PHPCs), these free tests will cease from **26 April 2022 onwards**.

Paid ART testing will still be available for members of the public at the CTCs/QTCs, GP clinics or via tele-ART providers.
